ACADEMICS

We are happy to announce that Mahajana Public School attained 100% result. Total 44 students appeared and 24 got more than 75% marks with distinction in various subjects. Kum.Shaik Tehseen, Kum. Khushi Shree and Kum Ganavi.M. P. are the toppers with 98%, 92 % and 91% marks respectively.

In order to bring all round development in children we have Innovation Lab, WEXL Multiple learning programs with smart boards , Karate classes, Dance classes, Music classes, Class wise Co-curricular activities, Intra school competitions and Bulletin Board competitions.

We are adopting various measures to achieve our goals, such as extra coaching classes for the board examinees, regular tests and examinations, four Pre-board examinations, competitive examinations such as Indian Talent Olympiad, a national level examination and All India General Knowledge Examination by centre of Human resource development and special counseling sessions and Personality development Programmes for children.

IN SPORTS COMPETITIONS: Our school, always motivates all activities to participates in extracurricular activities and encourages the children to play enthusiastically in different indoor and outdoor games.

With immense pleasure I introduce Kirtiraj Singh, a consistent winner of Ice-skating, a national player in skating. He is currently in grade 7th. His record breaking achievement in ice skating , recognized in the Indian Book of Record 2024. His remarkable achievements are 57 medals, 5 awards and 35 certificates in roller skating and 35 certificates in rollerskating and Ice skating. Along wthith this, he bagged 5 gold medals in the Ice-skating Championship held between 2022-25 at Gurugram and Himadri.

A proud moment for India was, he won two gold medals at the Asian Open Short Track speed Skating trophy2025.Presently he is in China getting ready for bringing medals for our country.

Our school children from grade first to ninth have participated in different games like Karate, wrestling, cricket, volley ball and Throw ball and brought laurels to the institution.
